*BRICK RESTORATION: The HTCS facilities committee reviewed the structure of the building during the 21-22 school year and determined that replacing brick and tuckpointing of the building was a high priority. In the fall of 2022, the board approved the project and a loan was secured through the Diocese of St. Cloud. Holy Trinity received a donation from the estate of Alcuin "Bumpy" Faust, who was a lifelong supporter of Holy Trinity and Catholic education.
