# REVERANCE OF CHRIST AND THE TABERNACLE:

One of the main focal points in our church is the tabernacle. The word tabernacle means dwelling place and it contains the "holy of holies". Jesus, present in the Eucharist. We believe that at every Mass, the bread and wine becomes Jesus—his body, blood, soul and divinity-even though we can't fully understand how it happens. The miracle of the Eucharist is a mystery, something that human reason and intelligence can never fully grasp.

This is why we genuflect, or if physically limited, bow to the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ as we enter and exit the church. The placing of our right knee to the ground signifies adoration and is rightful worship and adoration of our Lord.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines genuflection as "a reverence made by bending the knee, especially to express adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. By genuflecting or bowing deeply in a spirit of prayer and as a sign of adoration of the Lord, "we express our faith in the real presence of Christ under the species of bread and wine.". (CCC. 1378). To honor the true presence of Jesus Christ, all who pass before the Most Blessed Sacrament outside of Mass, as well as when entering of leaving the church, should genuflect.

This is also why we come to sit in the church for prayer, whether exposed in the monstrance or reposed in the tabernacle, we come to worship, pray and adore. Blessings, Deacon Craig
