

#### A MESSAGE FROM DEACON CRAIG KORVER



Dear friends in Christ,

Just a couple of weeks ago I began a new adventure, one that is leading down a path I would not have chosen for myself, yet knew I was supposed to take. I'm sure many of you can relate to that feeling. Fr. Aaron asked me if I would be willing to serve in our ACC in a new position in a part-time basis, to serve our community in the role of "Music Director."

This sounds official, but it is really more of being a liaison, someone to facilitate, communicate, coordinate, and help educate. What this is on a practical level is to assist the musicians we currently have, and help recruit and encourage more people in our community to offer the gifts they have to the Lord and the celebration of the Mass as we are guided by the Church and Sacred Tradition, all for the glory of God, worship due to Him, and for our sanctification.

You may ask, why this emphasis and focus on music? The music of the Mass is intended to offer our worship to God, and direct our hearts, in spirit and truth, into the mystery being revealed and made present to us in the holy sacrifice of the Mass.

The Church solemnly teaches us, then, that the very purpose of sacred music is twofold: the glory of God and the sanctification of the faithful. This understanding would preclude the common notion that we take the Mass and simply "tack on" four songs (the opening hymn, offertory hymn, communion hymn and recessional hymn), along with the sung ordinary of the Mass (Gloria, Sanctus, etc.). We must come to see that, since sacred music is integral to the Mass, the role of sacred music is to help us sing and pray the texts of the Mass itself, not just ornament it.

My invitation to each of you is to ask the Lord where is the Lord asking you to go that you would not choose on your own, or dare to on your own?

If the Lord is calling you, or you have a desire to share your musical gifts; as an organist, pianist, or cantor/choir member, or if you want training and lessons in these areas, please reach out to me at the parish office and I will get back to you.

Dare to go where God leads, you'll never regret the journey!




MAGNIFICAT SUBSCRIPTION: We have had inquiries into ordering the yearly
