#### **All Things New Prayer and Vocation Prayer**

Dear Friends.

Last week the bulletin article, bulletin insert and an announcement at Mass were about the St. Cloud Diocese' Parish Plan 2.0 called, "All Things New: Honoring the Past, Inspiring the Future." The bulletin message and the insert gave important information and statistics about the current state of the

priest shortage, declining attendance at Mass and other important related information regarding the reasons for possible changes in the future. The Director of Parish Planning, Brenda Kresky, gave a timeline of late March to early April for when the criteria for the changes would be made known to the ACC's. (Area Catholic Communities)

It can be difficult to face the reality of the situation but we must also remember that the Lord is with us in the changes and will see us through to a brighter future when we entrust our hopes and prayers to Him through our Blessed Mother. That is why we will begin praying the "All Things New" prayer for the Diocese planning after the rosary before Mass, and the "Vocations Prayer" after the petitions at each Mass. I want to encourage each person to pray these two prayers daily as well. When we are united in prayer and entrust our hopes and dreams to our Lord and Our Lady, our expectations will be far exceeded. Prayer moves mountains! Please see the two prayers in the bulletin and cut them out to put them in a place that will remind you to pray them each day.


