

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AARON NETT



Preparing Well for Holy Mass

Dear Friends.

When I was younger, and quite involved in sports, I focused on getting enough practice time in so that I was well-prepared for the game. Being well-prepared is of course a virtue (habit) that one can work on which applies to many more important areas of life than sports. The offering of ourselves at the Mass is the most powerful and important prayer we have as

Catholics. Therefore, shouldn't we prepare better for Mass than we do for anything else in our life?

St. Peter Julian Eymard said, "Know, O Christian, that the Mass is the holiest act of religion. You cannot do anything to glorify God more, nor profit your soul more, than by devoutly assisting at it, and assisting as often as possible."

Each and every Mass Heaven comes down to earth into the simple offering of bread and wine. And as God humbles himself to be made one of us, so we are called through his grace, to be made like him. What an amazing and unique gift that we are given in the Holy Eucharist. Below are some guidelines from the Church and practices to help deepen our experience and graces received:

Church Guidelines:

- 1. One must be a practicing Catholic in a state of grace
 - a. Canon Law states: In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, participants should not be conscious of grave sin and normally should have fasted for one hour. A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior sacramental confession except for a grave reason where there is no opportunity for confession (canon 916). A frequent reception of the Sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.
- 2. Fast from food and drink for one hour. (unless for reasons of age or illness)

Good Preparation Practices:

- 1. Read over the readings before Mass (speak about them with another if possible)
- 2. Come early to pray before Mass (rosary or silent time)
- 3. Have a regular, routine prayer time each day (15-20 minutes minimum)
- 4. Turn down the radio to pray and reflect in the car on the way to Mass.
- 5. Reflect on your intentions you bring into Mass.
- 6. Frequent confession (every month helps us go deeper with Christ)
- 7. Kneel down and pray for a few minutes after Mass (thank God for graces received)
- 8. Wear your Sunday best to give your best for the Lord.
- 9. Talk about what graces you received or what message you took away (support each other)

May God bless our efforts to prepare well for the Holy Mass and receive his abundant love and grace. May we "become what we receive."


