A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTORAL ADMINISTRATOR, ADAM HERMANSON



Dear brothers and sisters,

When it comes to the sacraments, one can find it is easy and convenient to overlook the mystery behind encountering God through them. The sacrament of baptism is no different. Some of the biggest questions that people ponder are 'why?' and 'what?'. Why was Jesus baptized? What effect does it have on the soul and mean for the Church, as the Mystical Body of Christ?

In the Gospel of Matthew 3:14-15, St. John the Baptist asked Jesus, "I need to be baptized by you, yet you are coming to me?" Jesus replies, "Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Scholars have taught us that, at that very moment, Jesus sacramentalized the waters of baptism during his immersion. Because Jesus is the ultimate model for Christians, we are called to follow his example. St. Paul writes about baptism and its effects throughout all his letters in the New Testament. For Instance, Romans 6:4 explains that, "We were indeed buried with him through baptism unto death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life."

The reality is, when we are baptized, we are born again into a new life in Christ (John 3:3-7). Original sin is completely washed away and we become heirs and adopted children of Gods heavenly kingdom. The Holy Spirit enters the soul that is baptized and dwells there because it has become a pure vessel and temple. The Lord also pours graces and gifts according to his measure and divine will upon the soul as well. A person that has received the sacrament of baptism has been made a completely new creation, where the old has gone and the new has come! (2 Corinthians 5:17)

The gifts of the sacraments always come with a duty and a responsibility. Parents have a duty to baptize their children. The Acts of the Apostles depict how the early church would baptize entire households. The Church provides resources for parents to help with this fundamental teaching of the Church. Since baptism is the gateway to all the other sacraments, it is something we shouldn't take lightly.

On a side note, Reborn is a wonderful presentation about baptism and can be accessed on FORMED.
