Fasting to be More

Dear Friends,

In this past Ash Wednesday's opening Collect to begin the season of Lent it states, "Grant, O Lord, that we may begin with holy fasting this campaign of Christian service, so that, as we take up battles against spiritual evils we may be armed with weapons of self restraint." I must say I love the powerful wording of the phrase "weapons of self restraint." It's not often that the church uses military language to describe the spiritual life. However, the service that we seek to grow in this Lent is to do battle against evil by denying ourselves so that we can be more of our true selves for others.

When we think of fasting, we normally think of fasting from food. Fasting from food is a very important spiritual pillar of the Christian life. We can also fast from our phones, television, certain music, TV, and other areas of our lives where we fall into excess, self indulgence and even addiction.

We live in a culture that tells us that "more and bigger is better." And if we have more, we will be happier. Each convenient store we walk into is lined with "king-sized" candy bars, extreme fire breathing potato chips, or energy drinks that make your hair stand up straight. But we know that more is not always better and sometimes is too much. Sometimes more is destructive for us and those around us. But, actually less is more.

Fasting is a weapon of self restraint that tempers and disciplines the bodily appetites and desires and helps to develop the virtue of self control. Someone that fasts perhaps on Fridays by eating only one meal and no red meat, is developing the ability to deny the appetite and be free of the attachment to food. Fasting from food also has many physical benefits and has been known to help in the aspect of clarity of the mind. But these reasons for fasting are not the most important reasons.

The most important reason for fasting is because Jesus fasted. Jesus Christ, the Son of the Living God, fasted for 40 days and nights to fend off the attacks of the evil one. Jesus also cast the demon out of the possessed boy after his disciples were unsuccessful, because he both fasted and prayed. Fasting has a spiritual element that makes prayer more efficacious and powerful. Fasting elevates the one that prays, and in a mysterious way, brings life to the soul. In this way the pillars of prayer, fasting and alms giving are connected and essential to each other. St. Peter Chrysologus once said, "Fasting is the soul of prayer; mercy is the lifeblood of fasting. Let no one try to separate them. They cannot be separated."

May this campaign of Christian service be a time for us to take up the weapon of fasting. May fasting help us to seek less for ourselves so that we can be free and more of our true selves.

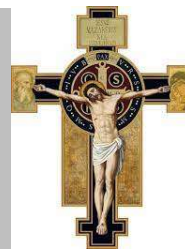
