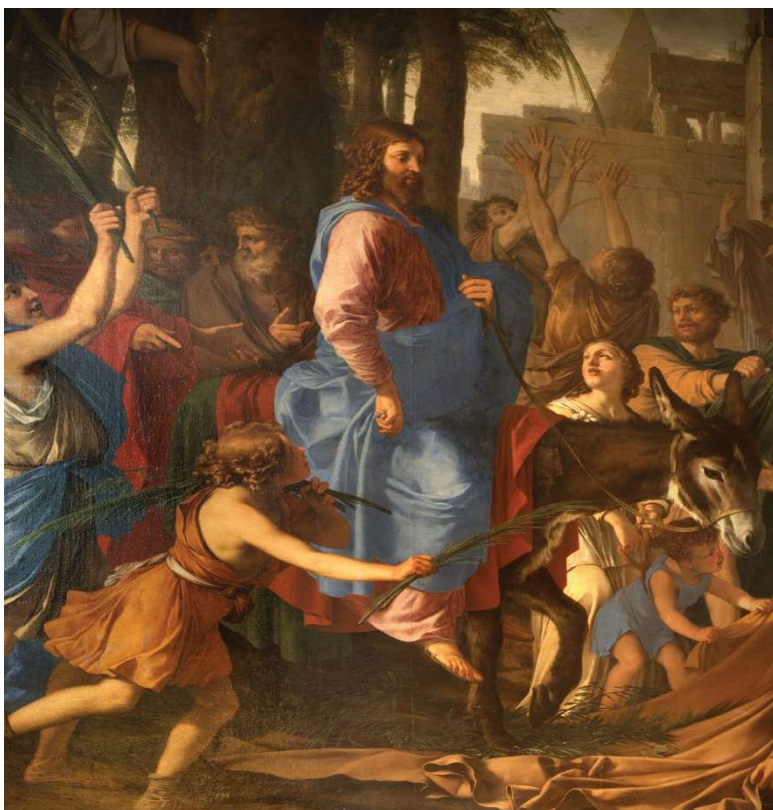

## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AARON NETT



### The Most Important Week of the Year

Dear Friends,

As we begin this most solemn week of, *Holy Week*, we are given an opportunity to enter into the Pascal Mystery of Jesus Christ, our Suffering Savior, so that we can die with Him and rise with Him.

We begin the week on what has been referred to as “*Spy Wednesday*.” Wednesday is the day that Jesus was betrayed by one of His own disciples for selfish gain and given over for thirty pieces of silver. Some fasting on this day would be appropriate. (A fast that is challenging and also fitting for the individual's work and health.)


Holy Thursday is the beginning of the Sacred Triduum (or three days) in which one continuous liturgical service is stretched out until the Easter Vigil. We have the beautiful Mass of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday, where Jesus lays down His life and institutes the Holy Eucharist; His own Body given as food for the soul. The washing of the feet symbolizes Jesus’ total self-giving as he teaches his disciples how to serve humbly the lowest of all people. The Eucharistic procession concludes the solemn night as Jesus goes off to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane where he is handed over and arrested. We are called to “*keep watch and pray*” as Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is held until Midnight.

On Good Friday, we chant, “*Jesus, remember me, when you come into your Kingdom,*” as we mourn our own sinfulness and remember the love that Christ has for us, even onto death on a cross. We adore and venerate the Holy Cross on which the Savior of the world was hung, knowing that our sins put Jesus on that cross which he bore for our salvation. Fasting and abstinence is required on Good Friday.

The finale of the Triduum and the height of the entire year is the Easter Vigil and Easter Mass. The “Easter fire” is stoked and blessed and the new Easter candle is processed into the darkened House of God, as one light pierces the darkness. The light is passed on and spread throughout the body of believers warming and lighting up the entire church with the fire that God created. The *Exultant* is sung as we rejoice that the tomb is empty and sing the “A” word, or *Alleluia*! “*Christ the Lord has risen today!*” We rejoice and give thanks, for our ultimate hope is that God has redeemed us, saved us and set us free!

I hope you are able to experience an outpouring of graces that God wishes to pour out upon all of us this Holy Week. May God bless, protect and fill us with his love.

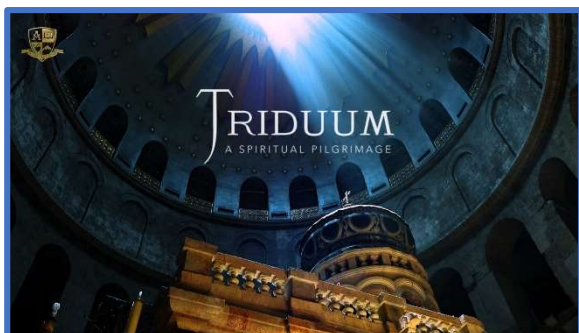

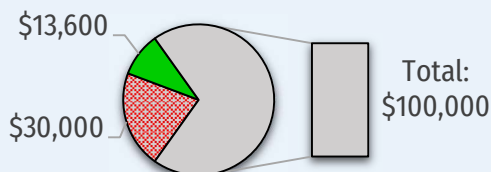

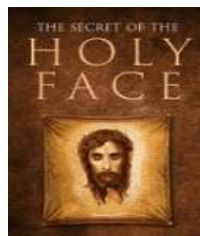
