A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AARON NETT



May the Month of Mary

Dear Friends.

Each May as spring brings about new life in nature and a time of rejoicing in the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, we also rejoice and give thanks to our mothers, who nurture us, teach us and carry us in their wombs. Spiritually speaking, we rejoice this May in our Blessed Mother who looks after us with powerful intercession and love.

The passage from Revelation chapter 12 calls the woman's appearance "a great sign" which "appeared in heaven," indicating that she is the mother of the Jewish Messiah and has "the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars." Accordingly, Catholic iconography of the Western tradition often depicts the Virgin Mary's assumption into heaven in this manner.

It makes logical sense that the mother of the Savior would have such an exit from this world and an entry into the next. St. John of Damascus wrote in a sermon on the Assumption as said, "It was fitting that she, who had kept her virginity intact in childbirth, should keep her own body free from all corruption even after death," and "that she, who had carried the creator as a child at her breast, should dwell in the divine tabernacles."

We are so blessed to have the rosary lead before each daily and weekend Mass so that we can pray this wonderful prayer together as a parish family before the greatest prayer, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. I encourage everyone to make the rosary a daily routine of both personal and family prayer. The rosary is making a return. St. Josemaria Escriva once said, "The holy Rosary is a powerful weapon. Use it with confidence and you'll be amazed at the results."

I encourage families to teach the children how to pray the rosary. Here are a few things to remember. 1. The decades of the rosary are meant to be time to reflect on Jesus' life. 2. The rosary is a prayer to ask for the Blessed Mother to intercede to God for us. We honor and pray to the Mother. We do not worship her. 4. The rosary is more powerful when said in groups or pairs. 5. The rosary is a great defense against evil and a source of grace.

CATHOLIC Q & A The Tradition of Genuflection

Q: Why do Catholics genuflect?

A: Genuflection is an act of devotion that literally means "to bend the knee." For many Catholics, it's an almost automatic gesture that we perform before entering our pew or row of seats at Mass. But, like many of the symbols and gestures of our faith tradition, genuflecting can also be an invitation for deeper reflection. The practice of "bending the knee" is an ancient way of recognizing the presence of someone greater than we are. It has been said that the practice dates back to the time of Alexander the Great, but it became a common part of etiquette in the royal courts of the Middle Ages. From throne rooms and palaces, it was a small step to genuflecting becoming part of the devotional lives of Christians, who used this secular gesture as a way of recognizing the presence of the One who is King of Kings, especially in the Eucharist. Today, Catholics are asked to genuflect in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament (whether in the tabernacle or exposed on the altar during eucharistic adoration). So, while it has become second nature to genuflect before entering your seat in church, we should pay attention to where the Blessed Sacrament is kept in each church or chapel that we visit, and genuflect in the direction of the tabernacle where the Blessed Sacrament is kept. In churches or chapels in which the tabernacle is in a separate space, we are invited to simply bow toward the altar. In addition to genuflecting before the Blessed Sacrament, we are also instructed to genuflect before the cross used for veneration on Good Friday (during the solemn celebrations of the Lord's Passion) and any time a relic of the True Cross is displayed for veneration. This long-standing tradition is a way of honoring the cross as the great sign of our salvation and of showing devotion to the passion of Jesus. **©LPi**


